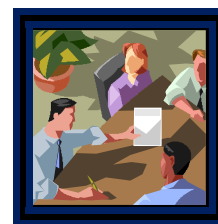

Matthew Mullaney practices law in McMinnville, specializing in Senior Law. He regularly assists persons with Wills, Trusts, Powers of Attorneys, Medical Advance Directives, Medicare and Medicaid, Guardianship & Conservatorship, and Probate. He was first licensed to practice law in the District of Columbia in 1964. After 19 years of law practice in the District of Columbia and Idaho, Mr. Mullaney returned to school, obtained a nursing degree at Boise State University. He worked for two years as a Registered Nurse in a nursing home and then a medical-surgical hospital unit in Boise, Idaho. He returned to the practice of law in 1987, blending nursing and the law in a practice that has since become known as "Senior Law" or "Elder Law". Moving to West Virginia in 1988, he also used his law and nursing to defend doctors and hospitals in malpractice suits, in addition to his Senior Law practice. He moved to McMinnville in 1995 and since then has built up a successful Senior Law practice.
